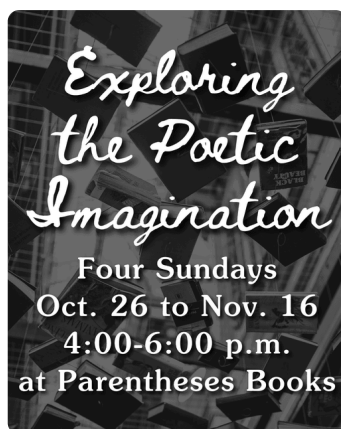


Dear Writers,

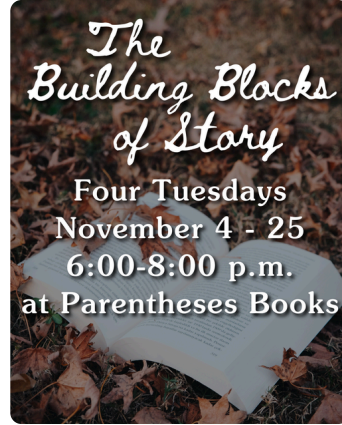
Exploring the Poetic Imagination
